Dear Parents and Caregiver of Our Scholars,

Scholarts Preparatory & Career Center for Children continues to make academic progress. Indeed all of our sixth graders were reading two to three levels below grade when they newly enrolled in our school last August; but almost 75% of those same children were proficient on state tests last spring. Remarkably, these children advanced two to three grade levels in reading in **one** school year. Our children in the third grade performed similarly in reading. We are proud of this achievement and we will continue to improve our services and supports to your child and family!

The federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) law requires **all** children in grades 3-8 to demonstrate proficiency in reading and mathematics. We are making tremendous progress- but not ALL Scholarts children have met this goal. For that reason, please know that we have been identified as being in our second year of School Improvement (SI). Therefore, you may choose Supplemental Educational Services (SES) for your child. SES is defined as permitting Scholarts children to receive after school tutoring in reading or mathematics by a private provider at no cost to you. Priority will be given to students who receive a free or reduced lunch. Please be aware that All About Learning educational services will provide tutorial services for Scholarts children on site at our school but these tutoring sessions are not supervised or affiliated with the Scholarts District. Also, please know that you are responsible for all transportation to and from these after school tutoring services. A list of other SES providers from which you may choose may be found at <http://www.ode.state.oh.us> then search SES. A list of SES providers is also available in the school office. You may sign up for the tutoring by completing the enclosed form and returning to the address on the attached flyer no later than October 12, 2009 by 4:00 p.m.

We are happy to provide several intervention programs such as Applied Scholastics Literacy Program and after school tutoring that address each area of need. The Applied Scholastics professional development and literacy program aims to bring all children to grade level performance in mathematics and reading. We are continuing our computerized program, Study Island which directly aligns technology and the core curriculum to achievement tests.

To move our school out of school improvement status we continue to respect our families, offer tutoring, highly qualified teachers in core subject areas, increased technology in classrooms, and ongoing assessment-driven strategic planning. Scholarts Preparatory & Career Center for Children continues to make academic progress. Indeed all of our sixth graders were reading two to three levels below grade when they newly enrolled in our school last August; but almost half of those same children were proficient on state tests last spring. Therefore, in compliance with federal NCLB requirements, parents of our scholars must be offered Public School Choice. Public School Choice means that the child would attend another school that would not be in SI in another district. Title I funding supports the transportation costs but if you choose to go back to the home school district there is no transportation support. Please refer to the Ohio Department of Education's website at <http://www.ode.state.oh.us> where you may access all schools' report cards and find the schools that are not in school improvement status throughout the state of Ohio from which you may choose. We are happy to provide several intervention programs for all Scholarts children in grades 3-8 and above as needed such as Applied Scholastics Literacy Program and after school tutoring that address each area of need. The Applied Scholastics professional development and literacy program aims to bring all children to grade level performance in mathematics and reading. We are continuing our computerized program, Study Island which directly aligns technology and the core curriculum to achievement tests.

To move our school out of school improvement status we continue to respect our families, offer tutoring, highly qualified teachers in core subject areas, increased technology in classrooms, and ongoing assessment-driven strategic planning. In 2008 Scholarts tripled the number of our children rated proficient in reading and math over the number in 2007 and thus we met the Ohio requirement for academic achievement. We achieved a 96.5% attendance rate in 2008, and 95% average attendance for 2007 and 2008, exceeding Ohio's requirement of 93%. We are proud of these achievements and we will continue to improve our services and supports to your child and family! Since our enrollment data were reported incorrectly to the state by an agency outside our school, and due to the agency not correcting its error by the state's deadline, (the agency has apologized to us) we have been **wrongly** and we believe unfairly identified as being in School Improvement (SI). Please read the letter of affirmation from the Chief Operating Officer at the Ohio Department of Education. Changes in the state reporting system will prevent such things from occurring in the future. However for now, in order to remain in compliance with federal NCLB requirements, parents of our scholars must be notified of Public School Choice. Public school choice means that the children may opt to attend another school that is not identified in SI in another district listed below. All 235 Scholarts children are eligible for transport to a district other than their district of residence and 15%, over \$10K of federal funding could be used for transportation. However, due to the excellent educational program at Scholarts, none (0) of our children have participated in public school choice and despite the error have **wisely chosen** our school. To move our school out of SI status we continue to pursue a remedy for the reporting error, respect our families, offer tutors, global languages, highly qualified teachers, technology, our career center, and ongoing assessment-driven strategic planning. Parent involvement is a key factor in educational success and we value your assistance with our efforts. Scholarts will continue our efforts to raise achievement to even higher levels confident that our children will show proficiency in all subject areas.

Dear Ms. Brown:

Thank you for your letter of December 23, 2008 in which you offered information regarding data discrepancies and their impact on the Scholarts Preparatory School's 2008 Report Card. I appreciate the work done by Dr. Parchia, her staff and your office in evaluating the reporting errors and related issues.

We understand the challenges inherent in execution of responsibilities in the complex data environment of public education. We also are keenly aware that reporting errors can impact a school's standing in our state's accountability system. This is why our system includes a period of evaluation for verification and correction by reporting entities. Unfortunately, once that period has expired and the official data tables have been established, the department does not recast prior reporting or re-characterize a school's standing in the accountability system.

I have, however, reviewed the contents of your letter with our technical staff. Based on those discussions I can verify the student records, as determined by the Statewide Student Identification (SSID) numbers, do support your presentation of those students having been appropriately withdrawn and thus removed from the school's funding determination. We have also determined that the type of reporting errors you identified would have a detrimental effect on a school's performance index. That index, as you noted in your letter, is a key factor in determining a school's classification within the accountability system. While the Ohio Department of Education cannot authenticate third party calculations it does appear the approach to determination of the impact of the reporting errors taken by Dr. Parchia's team is sound.

I appreciate the information you have shared on this matter through correspondence and conversation. Based on those communications, I feel confident that the school's administrative team is taking the steps necessary to assure that this is not a continuing problem.
